Ir Dr LAU is a Fellow of the Hong Kong Institution of Engineers (HKIE) within the Building Services Discipline. Early in his career, he also held a Fellowship with the UK Chartered Institute of Plumbing and Heating Engineering (CIPHE), establishing his strong technical foundation in public health and environmental design.

Over 17 years, Ir Dr LAU practised building services engineering on a range of challenging projects before joining the Hong Kong Green Building Council (HKGBC) in 2012. There, he took on a key leadership role managing Hong Kong's green building rating scheme, driving local industry standards toward higher environmental efficiency.

Beyond his executive duties, Ir Dr LAU remains an active thought leader committed to advancing industry knowledge. He has authored over 30 technical articles published across engineering and construction journals. His research and commentary focus heavily on hygiene issues and drainage system design, offering crucial insights at times of pandemics including the SARS in 2003 and COVID-19 in 2020-2023.
