

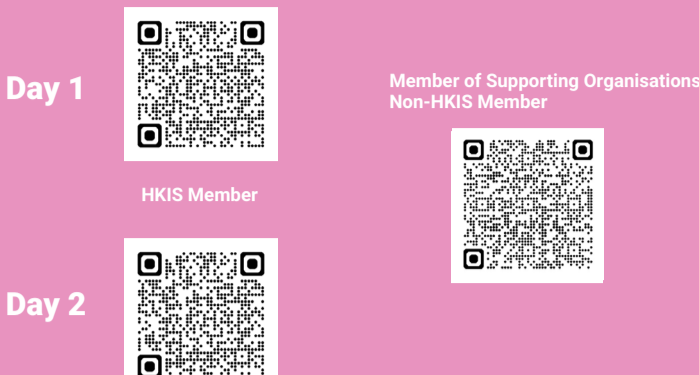
# Hong Kong Surveying Profession in Greater Bay Area Opportunities and Challenges for Advancing Net Zero Project and Property in Technological Era
