## Daikin and UNESCO formalise commitment on UN SDGs

Earth Overshoot Day fell on 1 August this year – the day when humanity's demand for ecological resources exceeds what the Earth can regenerate in a year.


At a country level there's a stark difference – as late as November for some, and as early as February for others.
