NDC Scorecard tool to strengthen national action on buildings

Ahead of the 2025 update cycle for country climate action plans under the Paris Agreement (known as [NDCs](#) or nationally determined contributions), the World Green Building Council (WorldGBC) has launched an NDC Scorecard project, to create a tool to support the evaluation and strengthening of nation-level policy on the built environment.

The tool is being co-developed with five pilot Green Building Councils (GBCs), alongside the GBC global network and local stakeholders, including governments, to help nations be bold on buildings in their NDC submissions and national policies.

The Americas begin their journey with national decarbonisation roadmap

On 9–10 September 2024, WorldGBC, 12 Green Building Councils (GBCs), industry leaders and financial and cooperation organisations met in Antigua, Guatemala, to define the next steps on the decarbonisation, resilience and sustainable financing of the construction sector in the Americas region.

The path for achieving ambitious decarbonisation and climate resilience roadmaps is being defined by WorldGBC's Americas Regional network.

INDICATE wraps up with report to pave way for INDICATE LIFE

The [INDICATE](#) project concluded with the release of its final report outlining crucial recommendations for implementing Whole Life Carbon (WLC) data across Europe. The report also features insights from pilot projects in Czechia, Spain and Ireland.

Our network has been represented at many exciting events this month, which have been placing the sustainable built environment firmly on the climate agenda.


